What is Employment Training?

Employment training is a time-limited support that assists job seekers to develop work related skills in preparation for community employment. Training is provided on an individualized basis and may include:

- Transferrable skill training
- Health and safety on the job
- Job readiness classes
- Career exploration
- Workplace expectations
- Résumé writing
- Interview preparation
- Employment applications
- Work experience
- Linkage to job placement
