

Respite Services

Short-term, scheduled respite for children and adults with intellectual disabilities who reside in London or Middlesex County.

What are respite services?

Respite services offer temporary respite for caregivers by providing centre-based care to people with an intellectual disability. Community Living London has three unique homes with qualified staff members to provide care to people of all ages and needs.

What are the benefits?

Respite services are an opportunity for children and adults to meet new friends while families and caregivers take time for themselves and other family members.



Who are they for?

Weekend Relief: Offers children 18 and under respite opportunities from Friday evening through Sunday evening. This home can accommodate up to eight children each weekend. Respite is provided all year long except for holiday weekends.

Extended Relief: This fully accessible home accommodates up to five people of any age. Flexible, extended respite is offered year round.

Adult Retreat: Offers adults respite in an apartment setting two weekends per month. We focus on developing independent living skills while accessing and enjoying a variety of activities in their community.
