WHAT IS IT?

Transition to Community Employment provides the opportunity for people with intellectual disabilities to develop employment skills to reach their employment goals.

WHO CAN ACCESS THESE SUPPORTS?

Training opportunities are available to people who:

- Are interested in developing work skills in a production oriented environment
- Are currently not employed
- Have a goal to be competitively employed
- Are not ready and/or not eligible for ODSP Employment Supports or Employment Insurance
- Are not currently receiving employment supports or other significant supports



WHAT'S INVOLVED?

Transition to Community Employment provides multiple steps to assist people to develop employment skills.

Opportunities may include:

- Introductory Assessment
- Identification of Employment Goals
- Job Readiness Classes
- Social, Sexual Awareness Classes
- Work Skill Development Opportunities
- Supported Work Experience
- Referral
